



### **STAL VAN DECRAEN SERIES 2008**

*3 Events make up this series for 2008*

1. The S.A. Young Riders Championship.

*Taking place at the Youth Extravaganza at Maple Ridge 18<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> July 2008*

*Prizemoney for the Championship R 20,000.00*

2. The SA Young Riders Grand Prix

*Taking place at the S.A. Championship in Durban 6<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> August 2008*

*Prizemoney for the Grand Prix R 20,000.00*

3. The Gauteng Young Riders Championship.

*Taking place at The Discovery Show Burlington 31<sup>st</sup> October – 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2008*

*Prizemoney for the Championship R 20,000.00*

***In addition to the above sponsorship Lieven van Decraen is awarding the opportunity of a lifetime to the overall winner of this series.***

*The package for the overall winner will be a cash prize of R 10,000.00*

*Plus a flight to Belgium, all accommodation in Belgium is included in the prize.*

*Lieven will arrange a loan horse and the opportunity to ride in a young rider show in Europe. (The prizewinner will have 6 months from the close of the last event to use the prize package)*

***The overall Second place will take home a cash prize of R 5000.00.***

*The overall winner will be the rider that has accumulated the most points over the three competitions. A rider may compete on more than one horse in any of the competitions (depending on the rules of the individual competition) but only the points for one of their horses will count for the series. Where a rider has more than one horse in the class they will be required*

*to nominate which horse will count for that competition and the nominated horse must then be ridden before their other horse/horses*

*A points system will be used to arrive at the winner of the series. The system will be the same as the FEI World Cup Qualification system.*

*Only the best 2 scores from the results of the 3 competitions will be counted. It should be carefully noted that the 3<sup>rd</sup> or final competition is compulsory for all riders who wish to qualify for the overall prize of a trip to Belgium and the cash prizes for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place. In other words the highest points from the first or second competition will be taken into account together with the points gained in the final (3<sup>rd</sup>) competition to arrive at the ultimate winner and runner up of the series. Should there be an equality of points after the third competition, a jump off for the overall first prize will take place. The jump off will be held immediately after the final round of the third competition and will be held over the shortened jump off course for that third competition. Time will be the deciding factor in this final jump off. A draw between the competitors tying for first place will be held to establish the starting order in this final jump off.*
