Natalie has been established in Europe, based in Germany (between Hamburg/Bremen) for the past 14 years, and has considerable experience with good places on the International competition scene in dressage as well as wins in the National competitions.

Natalie has 2 horses, both are in full training with national German coach Jonny Hilberath. Her goal is to produce both horses to competitive Grand Prix during the course of next year. It is not impossible to attempt to qualify for 2012, but difficult to predict as the horses are only just coming up to that level now at home. For 2014 WEG and 2016 Olympics they should be strong contenders.

HORSES:

1. Rising 9 year old mare DEVINA working at a basic Grand Prix level at home but not established. Aim to compete on a national level in Germany at Prix St. Georg level and Inter 1 level in the 2nd half of this year and possibly at an International level, aiming for Inter 2 level towards the end of the year.
2. Rising 8 year old stallion DANZER showing the basics for Grand Prix but not established. Aim to compete on a national level in Germany at Prix St. Georg level and Inter 1 level in the 2nd half of this year.
