

ROAD TO WEG 2014

ETC Mission Statement is

- To make every effort to facilitate the preparation of a well trained, well prepared internationally competitive strong eventing team for 2014 WEG in Normandy, France
- To establish and facilitate with the Department of Sport and Recreation a TID Programme for young riders (12-25) such that there is a structure to identify, develop and assist proven talented young riders to emerge into the High Performance ranks

Road to WEG2014 and beyond

- JPC to commence the refining of his HP long list and the TID list during the provincial clinics in February 2012
- Graham Winn will assist JPC and be the local coach of the TID programme as approved by the ETC
- Subsequent to JP's February 2012 visit, an April 2012 to March 2013 schedule will be issued with dates of training camps and lines of communication
- An essential element of the **Road to WEG 2014** will be the availability of timeous suitable sequence of FEI * events at approved venues
- While the AHS protocol remains an issue it is expected that this will be favourably resolved by early 2014
- While the **Road to WEG 2014** remains self funded every effort will be made to obtain financial assistance. Any surplus realised during JPC visits will be used to create a fund for this purpose – (periodic reconciliations will be circulated)
- JPC to continue to be involved in and monitor European based SA riders
