2 INVITATIONS TO FOREIGN OFFICIALS

Approval must be obtained from SANEF in respect of all Foreign Officials invited to officiate at Recognised Events. Details of the official's qualifications must be given when requesting approval.

3 UNAVAILABILITY OF PRESCRIBED OFFICIALS

Should the prescribed level of official not be available, permission must be obtained from SANEF to use an official on the next lower panel.

4 OFFICIATING AT EVENTS OUTSIDE OF SOUTH AFRICA

Officials of SANEF's senior panels invited to officiate outside South Africa are requested to keep SANEF informed. This is necessary in order to maintain liaison within and outside South Africa, where possible to arrange for panel officials travelling to other countries to represent SANEF at conferences or meetings which might take place during their visit.

5 MANDATORY FEES TO COURSE DESIGNERS (Applicable to the showjumping discipline only)

CSI status events, National Championships (see Section 20) and their qualifying classes	R650 per day plus R650 set up fee
Other CSN status events	R500 per day plus R500 set up fee
Recommended for all other Recognised events	R400 per day plus R400 set up fee

Any variation to the above must be agreed to by the Organising Committee at the time the invitation is issued. For course designer that are VAT vendors, all fees shall be considered VAT inclusive unless the Organising Committee is also VAT registered in which case these fees may be considered VAT exclusive

Travelling expenses at a previously agreed rate shall be paid by the Organising Committee

6 FINES

The maximum fines that may be imposed in respect of offences listed in Rule No 17.11.5 are:

At National Championships (see Section 20) and their qualifying classes	R1,000
Other CSN Status events	R 500
All other Recognised events	R 300
Maximum fine that may be imposed in respect of an offence under Rule 12.2.5 (hard hat falling off)	R 200
