

SECTION 21A

THE ADULT SHOWJUMPING CHAMPIONSHIP OF SOUTH AFRICA

21A.1. COMPETITIONS PRIOR TO THE CHAMPIONSHIP

The Organising Committee shall include in the schedule a welcome stakes competition for Open horses. This competition shall not be related to the Championship or be treated as a qualifying competition for the championship.

21A.2 COMPETITIONS RELATED TO THE CHAMPIONSHIP

- 1 There shall be two qualifying competitions and one championship competition for which competitors must qualify.
- 2 Prize money and other awards shall be awarded as for a normal competition at the conclusion of each of the three competitions.

21A.3 QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS

1. First Qualifying Competition

1. This competition shall be run in accordance with Table A 17.10.4.2.1 (A2 Competition) with one jump-off. Speed 400 mpm.
2. The course shall consist of between ten and twelve numbered fences (i.e. between twelve and fourteen efforts)

2. Second Qualifying Competition

1. This competition shall be run in accordance with Table A 17.10.4.2.2. (AM5 Competition). Speed 400 mpm.
2. The course shall consist of between ten and twelve numbered fences (i.e. between thirteen and fifteen efforts) and shall include only one double combination and one treble combination. If possible the course should include a water jump.

21A.4 THE CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITION

1. This competition shall be run over two rounds of a Championship course of International standard and in accordance with Rule 18.10.3.2. (identical courses). Speed 400 mpm.
2. The course will consist of between ten and twelve numbered fences and shall include either one double and one treble combination or three double combinations, i e between 13 and 15 efforts. If possible a water jump

should be included in the course. If a water jump is included then it is obligatory that this water jump is included in one of the qualifying competitions.

3 The dimensions of the fences in the course may be altered for the second round at the sole discretion of the Course Designer.

4. The order of the starting for the second round of the Championship shall be on the basis of reverse order of merit of the first round.

5. Should there be a jump-off then the order of riding in the jump-off shall be the same as that of the second round.
