

SECTION 21B

THE JUNIOR AND PONY RIDERS'S INDIVIDUAL SHOWJUMPING CHAMPIONSHIPS OF SOUTH AFRICA

21B.1 CROSS REFERENCE AND APPLICATION

These rules shall be read in conjunction with, and are supplementary to, the General Regulations applying to all South African National Championship (Section 04).

21B.2 COMPETITIONS RELATED TO THE CHAMPIONSHIP

There shall be three qualifying competitions and one championship competition for which competitors must qualify.

21B.3 QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS

The Organising Committee shall include in the schedule the following competitions all of which shall be qualifying competitions. Prize money and other awards shall be awarded as for a normal competition at the conclusion of each of these competitions.

1 First Qualifying Competition

This Competition shall be run in accordance with Table A 17.10.4.2.1 (A2 Competition) with one jump off. Speed 350 mpm.

The course shall consist of between ten and twelve numbered fences (i.e. between twelve and fifteen efforts) and shall include only one double and one treble combination. If possible the course should include a water jump.

2 Second Qualifying Competition

This competition will be run in accordance with Rule 18.11 5.2 (Competition in Two Phases). Speed 350 mpm.

3 Third Qualifying Competition

This competition will be run in accordance with Table A 17.10.4.2.2 (AM5 Competition). Speed 350 mpm.

The course shall consist of between ten and twelve numbered fences (i.e. between thirteen and fifteen efforts) and shall include only one double and one treble combination. If possible the course should include a water jump.

21B.4 THE CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITION

1 This competition shall be run over two rounds of a Championship course of national standard and in accordance with Rule 18.10.3.2 (identical courses). Speed 350 mpm.

2 The course will consist of between ten and twelve numbered fences and shall include either one double and one treble combination or three

double combinations, i.e. between 13 and 15 efforts. If possible a water jump should be included in the course. If a water jump is included then it is obligatory that this water jump is included in one of the qualifying competitions.

3 The dimensions of the fences in the course may be altered for the second round at the sole discretion of the Course Designer.

4 The order of starting for the second round of the Championship shall be on the basis of reverse order of merit of the first round.

5 Should there be a jump-off then the order of riding in the jump-off shall be the same as that of the second round.

21B.5 FALLS

Following a fall in any round of the Championship or its qualifying classes, a competitor will not be allowed to compete in subsequent rounds unless, after an examination, the medical officials on duty are of the opinion that the competitor is fit enough to compete without incurring further injury.
