

# STAL VAN DECRAEN YOUNG RIDER SHOWJUMPING SERIES

## 1 THE SERIES

The Stal van Decraen Young Rider Showjumping Series will comprise four competitions held at different venues during a calendar year.

The classes will be

Young Rider's Table A Competition  
Young Rider's Grand Prix of South Africa  
Young Rider's Championship of South Africa  
Young Rider's Stal van Decraen Final Championship

All four classes in the series together with their preliminary classes will carry CSN Status and will be judged under Table A.

## 2 QUALIFICATION OF RIDERS (see also 01.9.3 and 04.5.1.1)

The Series is restricted to young riders (see General Regulations 01.9.0) from the beginning of the calendar year during which they reach the age of 16 to the end of the calendar year during which they reach the age of 21

For purposes of awarding Qualification Rounds all of the competitions are classified as Adult Competitions.

## 3 QUALIFICATION OF HORSES

Open to horses classified Open.

## 4 PRELIMINARY COMPETITIONS PRIOR TO EACH SERIES COMPETITION

1 At each event the Organising Committee shall include in the schedule at least one preliminary competition for Open horses at 1,30m or 1,35m, and one preliminary competition for Open horses at 1,35m or 1,40m competing separately. These classes must include the water jump if it is to be used in final young rider competition (qualifying competition) at that event.

2 In order to qualify to compete in a series competition, all competitors must have completed the first round of at least one of the two preliminary competitions held in terms of (1) above.

## 5 ORDER OF STARTING

1 The order of starting in the four series competitions shall be drawn.

2 Where possible, a gap of at least seven horses shall be allowed between horses ridden by the same rider. This shall be achieved by moving

that rider's first horse drawn upwards in the order of riding (see 01.14.0 and 01.17.0).

3 Should a rider have more than one horse entered in any of the series competitions, then that rider shall declare, prior to the commencement of the class, which horse will be going for series points, and that horse must be ridden first.

## **6 THE SERIES COMPETITIONS**

### **6.1 *Young Riders Table A Competition***

Held under SANEF Rule 17.10.4.2.2AM5

### **6.2 *Young Riders Grand Prix***

Held under SANEF Rule Section 22

### **6.3 *Young Rider's Showjumping Championship of S.A.***

Held under SANEF Rule Section 25

### **6.4 *Young Rider Stal van Decraen Final Championship***

Held under SANEF Rule No 18.10.3.3.2, with a different shortened second round course; the first round not against the clock and the second round against the clock. Competitors are placed according to their aggregate penalties over both rounds and the time incurred in the second round.

### **6.5 Rules**

All series competitions will be run over Championship courses of National Standard (1,40m/1,45m) at a speed of 400mpm. Preliminary classes at each event will be run at a speed of 350mpm.

## **7 ELIGIBILITY**

All competitions are open to all Young Riders qualified to compete in Open Classes. However, only riders who have competed in at least two of the first three competitions will be eligible to score points in the final competition.

## **8 POINTS**

Points will be awarded in accordance with the FEI World Cup Qualification points system as set out in 10 below.

## **9 CLASSIFICATION**

Only the points gained from the fourth series competition, together with the highest points gained from two of the first three series competitions will be taken into account to arrive at the ultimate winner and runner up.

Should there be a tie for first place overall after the fourth competition, the highest placed competitor in the final competition will be declared the Series Winner.
