



SANEF Jumping Riders Rankings

The system operates on the basic table of points which is dependent on the following two factors.

- Basic points are allocated depending on the number of horses that start in the competition (**all** CSN classes), that is horses that go through the start.
- Rankings are for a calendar year from Jan to Dec
- If a rider has more than one horse in a competition, points are allocated as per each placing. However the points are only awarded for that riders' highest placing, the other points are simply ignored – they are not allocated to another rider. The points may vary as the level of each competition.
- Rankings are not an indication of rider and horse combination's and not solely used for selection – please see selection criteria for Team selection.
- The Basic points system allocation works as follows:

Open Classes - Adult and Young Riders

1.35	x 2
1.40	x 3
1.50	x 4
S A Championships	x 5
World Cup Classes	x 5

Juniors

J 1.30	x 1
SA Championships	x 2.5

Pony Riders – Open Classes
