

**Cara Frew gains experience at the CSI\*\* Glatigny (FRA) and CSI\*\* Lummen (BEL)

Young Rider Cara Frew has been balancing riding her horses here in South African and in Europe. She recently returned from riding at the CSI\*\* Lummen in Belgium and the CSI\*\* Glatigny France. The first show was at the fantastic venue in Lummen with 3 different arenas all running simultaneously. She rode 3 of her horses in the small and medium classes. She had previously ridden Leopold at shows but it was the first time she competed on Chellango and Wito. She rode a total of 9 classes and was placed 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> respectively, she had one pole down on Leopold in the medium class on day one. Unfortunately Cara had one down in each class after that over the next few days so was not in the money again but always ended round the middle of the classes. She gained a lot of valuable ring experience in Lummen.

The next weekend was spent at the CSI\*\* in Glatigny – France where she rode another 9 classes, this time on Wito, Chellango and Little Lady D'Elle. She had a double clear on Chellango in the medium class on day one getting a 19<sup>th</sup> place on him and just in the money. She had a clear round on Wito in 2 classes, one medium where she ended up 14<sup>th</sup> and one big where she ended up 2<sup>nd</sup>, her highest placing in CSI shows in Europe so far. She also jumped her first ever Grand Prix. The top 60 riders qualified for the Grand Prix from 100 riders entered, it was quite a long course with tricky distances and turns, there were only 6 clears. Cara had 4 poles down, but still ended up around 40 out of the 60 starters.
