

Charles Luyckx and Olibero Qualify for WEG 2010 – Kentucky

Charles Luyckx had a fantastic end to the Spanish Sunshine Tour with only 4 penalties in the CSI4* Grand Prix in Vejer de la Frontera he qualified himself and his horse Olibero for the 2010 World Equestrian Games – Kentucky. Olibero is a 13 year old Dutch bred Gelding with phenomenal jumping bloodlines including Libero H, Jasper and Animo.

He is only about 15.2hh but is an incredible athlete and has the unique characteristics of being very brave but yet ultra careful. Charles has only been partnered with Olibero for about a year. Olibero was formally owned by leading British rider Richard Davenport who had bought him from top Dutch Dealer Jan Tops 5 years ago.

Charles grew up in South Africa riding thoroughbreds which is one of the reasons he says he clicked so well with Olibero as he is a sensitive horse who has a huge heart and always tries his best.
