- The selectors will have knowledge and experience to effectively select individuals and teams and will be free of all vested/conflict of interest as is possible.
- A register of Declarations of Interest will be maintained by the Secretary General and is available for inspection.

THE SHORT LIST WILL BE CONFIRMED BY THE NATIONAL SELECTION COMMITTEE AFTER THE APRIL/MAY 2012 SELECTION SHOW.

- Vaulters have to turn 14 in the year of the Championships and upper age is 18 years (must turn 18 in the year of the championship)
- All individual vaulters on the NTC selected long list who wish to enter the Championships, are required to qualify with an average score of **5.50** points or higher in Round 1 (comprising Compulsory and Free Tests) at an International CVI*, CVI ** or FEI approved qualifying show, in order to be eligible for selection.
- All individual vaulters on the NTC selected long list must compete in at least 3 of the 4 National selection shows. (see above). Results from International CVI** competitions will be taken into account for vaulters with a legitimate reason for not being able to attend the South African selection shows.
- The Mixed teams will be required to compete as a team, unchanged, in at least one of the 3 National selection shows. (see above)
- The Pairs will be required to compete, unchanged, in at least one of the 4 National selection shows.
- All individual, pairs and mixed team vaulters must be registered members of the FEI and their provincial body.
- Only South African citizens will be eligible for selection.
- Upon selection, athletes will be required to obtain an International License from SANEF.

All vaulters selected to represent SA at the Junior European Vaulting Championships will be required to submit the following;

- A copy of their South African passport
- A copy of their FEI registration
- A copy of their International License
- A letter from their provincial body stating that they are members in good standing
- A signed copy of the FEI anti doping agreement
- A signed copy of the SA Athletes agreement pertaining to code of conduct

The selector's decision will be sent to the SANEF Management Committee for ratification. The selected individuals, pairs and mixed team will be notified in writing by the National Selection committee by the end of June 2012.

NTC SELECTED LONG LIST-All competitors for individual and pairs selection must turn 14 years of age in the year of the Junior Championship. The upper age limit – vaulters must turn 18 years of age in the year of the Junior European Vaulting Championships 2012

*Please note that in the event of there being more vaulters qualified for International events who wish to participate than there are places, the National selection panel will make the final selection. Any vaulter who does not fulfil the requirements of the above selection criteria will not be considered for selection.

The decision of the National Selection Committee will be final and the selectors reserve the right to freely apply their expertise in carrying out their duties.
